



Black and Pink scarf

Time to do varies

Level intermediate

Instructions

1. Using the entire length of the long loom do 83 complete rounds (rows).
2. Make the tassels by taking 4-6 strands of black yarn and looping it through the end of the scarf. Then tie it off by taking two strands of pink yarn and just tying a knot over the top of the black therefore keeping it in place. By doing this it leaves you with 7 groupings of black and pink!
3. Note: You can always make the scarf longer or shorter according to your desired length. Because this string is very thin it weighs itself down so that it looks longer than when it's stretched out. Very chic!

What you will need

Provo Craft Supplies

Knifty Knitter scarf loom

(brand name not available) choose a very fine black yarn and the pink is kind of bumpy yet still thin
